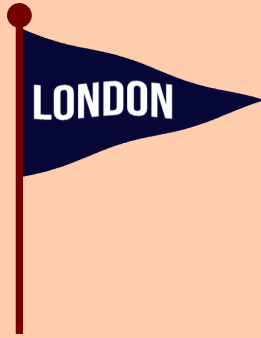
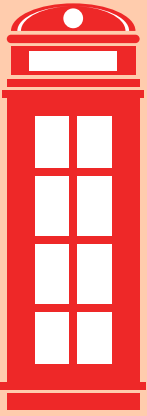
An interview with our Business Development Manager, Fahad Kazi

in the capital in a variety of different communities. Our diverse team of staff come from different cultures and can support the people of London in the best possible way.

The borough has one of the largest economies of all the London boroughs, comprising around 143,400 employee jobs and 12,500 business which creates a potential for increased commercial activity.

The area also benefits from shopping malls, cafes, restaurants, bars, theatres, hotels, gyms and more.

Hounslow (Chiswick) is an ideal location to setup the office due to its central location with easy access to other parts of London. The area has excellent public transport links which would enable us to provide services to a larger group of people. Chiswick has a total population of 271,767 out of which about 34,119 are aged 65 years and over. About 130,505 of Chiswick's population is white, representing about 51.4%.

There are reliable and accessible channels of transportation in Chiswick in view of its situation at the start of the North Circular Road, South Circular Road and the M4 motorway, the latter providing a direct connection to Heathrow Airport and the M25 motorway. There are also bus routes which run through the Chiswick High Road and includes 24-hour bus services.

The public transport network allows staff and clients to travel to and from Central London, Northwest London, Southwest London, South London, North London and beyond by train, tube or bus. The District line serves Chiswick with four London Underground stations, Stamford Brook, Turnham Green, Chiswick Park and Gunnersbury. These transportation systems provide easy mobility to other areas such as Ealing, Brent, Harrow, Hammersmith and Fulham etc.
